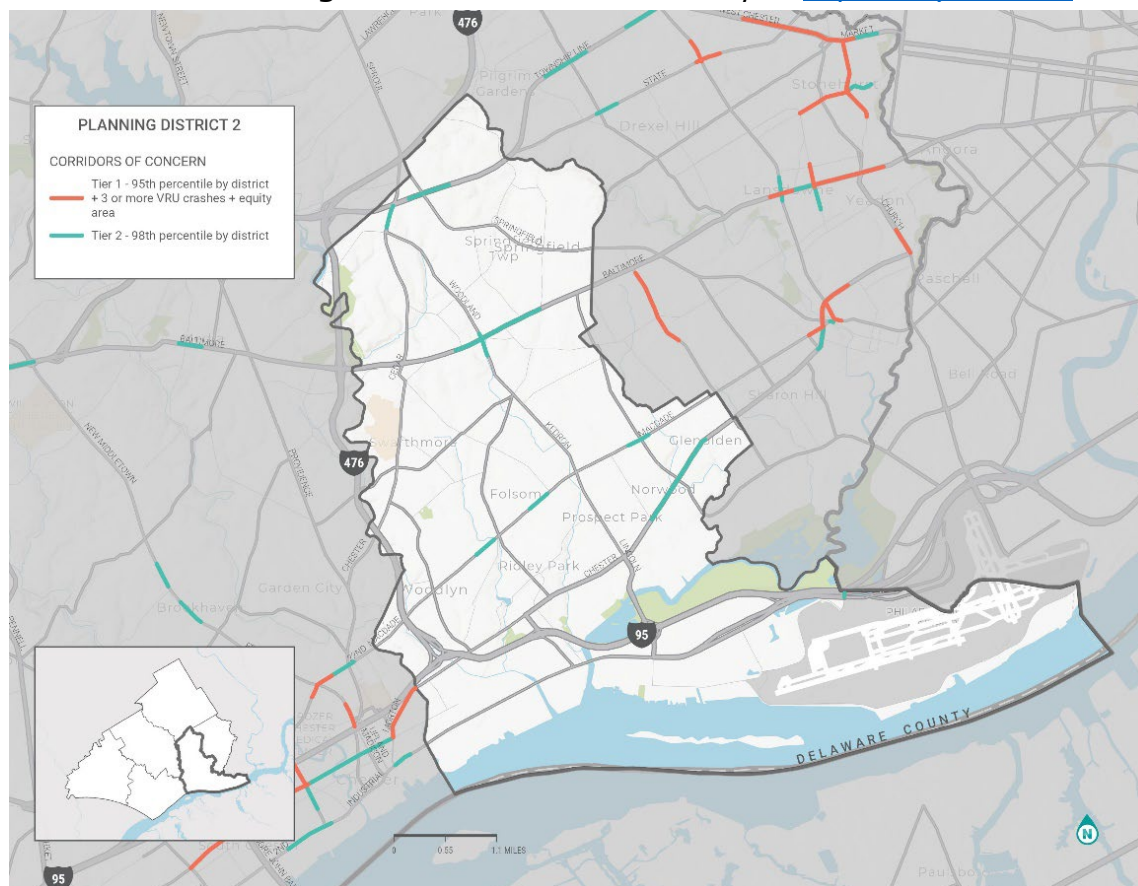


Corridor of Concerns - Planning District #2 Snapshot

Language - Higher levels of Spanish speaking residents can be found in Morton and Eddystone. - Higher levels of French speaking residents are found in the Morton area. Germanic language speakers are found in Morton, Springfield, and Swarthmore. - Levels of Slavic language speakers are higher in the Ridley Park, Morton, and Norwood areas. - High levels of Chinese speaking residents are found in Swarthmore and Morton. - There are higher levels of Vietnamese speaking residents in Springfield, Ridley, and the Lester neighborhood. - There are higher levels of Tagalog in Swarthmore and Prospect Park. - There are higher levels of Arabic speaking residents north of Ridley Park, as well as Round Lester and between Swarthmore and Morton.		
Vehicle Access 2.9% of households in this planning district do not have access to a vehicle.		
Population Density The population density of the area is 4,094 people/sq. mi. The population density of Delaware County is 2,869 people/sq. mi., and the population density of Philadelphia is 11,937 people/sq. mi.
